






How to Tie a Double Wrap Belt

Begin by finding the center of the belt by folding the belt in half.

The right side of the belt (knowledge stripe side) is wrapped around the waist first.</p>	<p>Holding the center of the belt on the student's stomach, wrap the right side (knowledge stripe side) around the waist first, then place the left side (rank stripe side) on top and wrap it around waist.</p>
 <p>The diagram shows the belt wrapped around the waist. The rank stripe side is being tucked underneath the knowledge stripe side.</p>	<p>Take the rank stripe side (which should be wrapped on top) and tuck it underneath the knowledge stripe side and the center of the belt to hold all pieces of the belt firmly together.</p>
 <p>The diagram shows the belt ends crossed in front of the waist to form an 'X' shape.</p>	<p>Cross both sides of the belt to make an "X" shape. Take the bottom side (knowledge stripe side) and bring it up and then down through the opening in your "X". Pull firmly and twist the belt ends downward to finish the knot.</p>
 <p>The diagram shows the finished double wrap belt tied around the waist, with the rank stripe on the right side and knowledge stripes on the left side.</p>	<p>Properly tied belts should end with the rank stripe on the right side of the uniform under the ATA patch on the uniform jacket and knowledge stripes on the left side of the uniform. Both ends of the belt should be equal in length.</p>
